Location: **Enroute to Frankfurt**

Description: **Cabin crew dizziness**

During a passenger flight on airplane TF-ISL (Boeing 757-200) from Keflavik Airport, Iceland, to Frankfurt/Main, Germany, members of the cabin crew suffered health problems during cruise. All cabin crew members continued their duty until the end of the flight. The cabin crew reported strong symptoms such as dizziness, headaches, blue lips as well as numbness in legs and fingers. The PIC then decided to inform the controller via radio and ask for a priority approach. Pilots and passengers were not affected. The serious incident was investigated by the German BFU and the Icelandic AAIB nominated an ACCREP to the investigation. The German BFU issued a report relating this serious incident on March 14, 2013.

The Icelandic Transportation Safety Board (ITSB) decided to close the case during a board meeting on October 24, 2013.
